The fabric changes appearance depending on the angle from which it is viewed. The change can range from a more matt and darker surface to a shinier and lighter coloured one. The change is also noticeable in those areas where the fabric is exposed to wear and tear. This change is typical of velour fabrics and is an expected and intrinsic feature of this material.
