The Opala Lighting Series presents a distinctive, almost futuristic expression with slightly tilted lampshades and straight lines. Opala Table Lamp features an asymmetric opal acrylic shade with a painted aluminium top, radiating a pleasant, focused light, while softly illuminating the surrounding space through the lampshade. Suitable for both the office- and living room. The table lamp is also available in a smaller version.






RECOMMENDED LIGHT SOURCE USED FOR MEASSUREMENTS






