

Safety precautions

- If in any doubt, assembly should be carried out by a licensed professional. Incorrect assembly may result in personal injury, product or property damage.
- Handle the product with care in order to not scratch the surface.
- Ensure any weight is evenly distributed across the shelf once installed.
- The product is intended for interior use only.
- Do not install the shelf near heat sources or in a humid
- Screws and plugs for fixing the shelf brackets to the wall are not included. Every wall will require different types of screws and plugs so please ensure to select the appropriate type for your walls.

Cleaning instructions

- Lacquered wood is a strong and durable material that is easy to clean and maintain.
- For daily care, it is recommended to dust the product with a soft, dry cloth. Lacquered wood can be cleaned with a soft cloth wrung in a mild solution of lukewarm water and a universal cleaning detergent. Always follow the wood grain and dry with a soft, dry cloth immediately after cleaning.
- Avoid use of abrasive cleaning agents and aggressive cleaning detergents as this will damage the surface of the lacquered wood. Avoid placing wooden furniture in direct sunlight, excessive heat or humidity.

Please follow steps 1-4 to assemble the product.

Step 1 / 4

For shelves measuring 750mm:

Using a spirit level, measure a 470mm line horizontally across the wall, marking a point at either end. Measure 85mm vertically up from each of these two points and make another set of marks, creating four points as per the illustration.

For shelves measuring 1200mm:

Using a spirit level, measure a 780mm line horizontally across the wall, marking a point at either end. Measure 85mm vertically up from each of these two points and make another set of marks, creating four points as per the illustration.



Make sure the marks are aligned to ensure the shelf will be level once installed. Drill holes into each mark and insert plugs suitable for the wall type.


Step 3 / 4


Align the brackets (A) with the drilled holes and secure in place with screws that are suitable for your wall type.


Do not tighten the lower screw fully, allowing a 1mm gap.

Step 4 / 4

Place the shelf (B) on the brackets and secure in place with the provided screws (D) and Allen key (C) until fully tightened. Tighten the lower screws on the wall mount.
