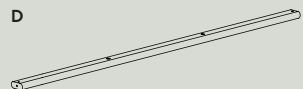
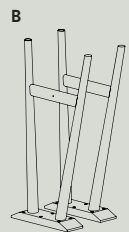

Safety precautions

- Dispose of plastic bag from packaging and do not allow children to play with it.
- The table is only intended for interior use.
- Handle table tops with care in order to not scratch the surfaces.
- Power tools can be used to assemble the table. Be careful not to overtighten or damage screw or thread.
- Two or more people are needed to assemble the table.
- Spilt liquids of any kind should be removed immediately from the table top as they may penetrate the surface treatment and cause irreparable damage.

Cleaning instructions

For daily care, all table tops can be dusted using a soft dry cloth.

- Veneer table top: Avoid using cleaning detergents and abrasive cleaning agents, as they may damage the surface of the wood. Avoid placing in direct sunlight, excessive heat or humidity.

- Solid wood table top: Cleaning can be done using a soft cloth wrung in lukewarm water following the wood grain and dried immediately with a soft, dry cloth.

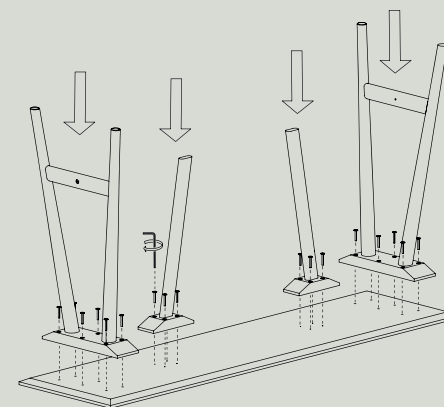
- Laminate table top: Laminate can be cleaned using a soft cloth wrung in a mild solution of lukewarm water and a universal cleaning detergent. Always wipe with a soft, dry cloth after cleaning. For difficult stains such as coffee or tea, use a nylon bristle brush with a mild household cleaner or detergent, rinsing with clean water and repeating as necessary. Rinse thoroughly with water before drying.

Step 1 / 2

Place the table top (A) upside down on a soft, flat surface.

Position the legs (B) and support columns (C) to align with the holes on the underside of the table as illustrated. Ensure that all components are correctly positioned: the legs should be slightly tilted outwards, and the support columns should be tilted inwards, as shown in the second drawing.

Secure all components in place with flat-headed screws (E).



Step 2 / 2

Position the wooden stretcher (D) on top of the support columns, ensuring all holes are aligned.

Secure the wooden stretcher by inserting the flat-headed screws into the support columns. Then, insert the threaded inserts (F) into both ends of the stretcher. Finally, connect the legs to the stretcher by adding flat-headed screws on either side as pictured.
