

Your Loafer is built to last and we hope that it will serve you for many years to come. The Loafer is covered with high quality fabric and can be easily separated from its base.


All fabric, foam and wooden parts can be separated and delivered to a suitable recycling station.

#### 5 year warranty




#### Disassembly

Please follow these x steps to disassemble the Loafer chair.


1. Begin the disassembly process of the loafer by removing the cushion from the base.



2. To separate the cushion into its components, open the zipper and remove the foam from the inside of the fabric sleeve.



3. Flip the chair upside down by placing it on the backrest and seat as shown in the illustration below. Ensure you have an additional person to perform this action safely.




4. Remove the gliders by pulling them out using a pair of pliers. Once the gliders are removed, you can separate the MDF board from the chair base.








#### Disassembly

5. Carefully cut open the back of the seat along the dotted line shown in the illustration using a knife or scissors.



6. Unscrew the fasteners inside the seat that connect it to the main frame. Turn them counter clockwise to remove them. Once all bolts have been removed, you can separate the seat from the chair.





7. To disassemble the seating panel, remove the staples along the dotted lines indicated in the illustration. Use a pair of pliers or a small flathead screwdriver to carefully pry them out.










8. Seperate the fabric from the base.




9. Carefully remove the foam padding from the wood using a spatula to scrape it off.



10. Remove the staples securing the fabric straps to the wooden frame to separate the straps from the wood.





11. Next, remove the staples along the dotted lines shown in the illustration. Use a pair of pliers or a small flathead screwdriver to carefully pry them out.








#### Disassembly

12. Carefully cut open the fabric along the dotted lines shown in the illustration with a scissor or a knive. Once cut, pull the fabric halfway down to seperate from the underlying structure.



13. Return the chair to its original upright position and gently separate the fabric by pulling it up and away from the chair. Ensure you have an additional person to perform this action safely.



14. Using a spatula, carefully remove the foam padding by scraping it off the wood.



15. Finally, dispose all components in their appropriate recycling streams. If necessary, break them down into smaller pieces for easier disposal.
